BRING YOUR COMPLETED ASSIGNMENT – The assignments will be handed in daily. To receive full credit, assignments must be turned in on time.

Binder

Binder checks will occur weekly at the end of the week. To earn full credit, students must maintain daily notes and assignments, even for days absent.

Assignments

Assignments are graded on a 10 point scale. To earn full credit (10 points), students must:

1. Write down ALL original problem information.
2. SHOW all work necessary to solve a problem.
3. CIRCLE or BOX the answer.

Late assignment: A late assignment is any assignment turned in at least one day late. For each day late, the assignment will lose 25% of the available points. Assignments more than 3 days late will receive NO credit.

Quizzes/Tests

Quizzes will be given throughout the study of a unit.

Tests will be given at the end of each unit and will include multiple choice, free response, and constructions.

Semester Final

The semester final is comprehensive and will cover all the material from the current semester of study.

Absences

1. Students are required to get missed notes from another student in the class. The notes will be graded per the weekly binder check.
2. Assignments due on the day of the absence must be handed in upon return. Any assignment handed in later will be classified as late and will be graded per the late assignment policy above.
3. Missed quizzes or tests from the day of absence will be made up on a day determined by the teacher. Arrangements must be made by the student to be available to take the make-up the quiz or test on the determined date. Any quiz or test not made up will receive a grade of zero.

Tardiness

If a student is not sitting at their desk when the bell rings, they will be marked as tardy on the attendance. Tardies are taken seriously. Five tardies will put a student on a contract. If a student accumulates 10 or more tardies in a semester, the student will be dropped from the class and put into a block class during the regular school day.

Extra Help

If you need extra help, be proactive and seek me out. I am available for additional help at lunch on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. I am also available during periods 3, 5, and 7 on Mondays.
