

PACIFIC GROVE HIGH SCHOOL
SCHOOL SITE COUNCIL
MINUTES 09/28/09

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 by Principal, Matt Bell. The members present were Abby Pfeiffer, Mary Beth Long, Adrian Schueneman, Kathy Butler, Katie Selfridge, Felicia Affi, Vivian Michael, Rachel Mein, Ilya Ollinger, Karinne Gordon and Eric Ceyress.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved as corrected: spelling of Haggquist was corrected and Agenda was changed to Minutes

New officers were elected. Abby Pfeiffer will serve as Chairperson and Adrian Schueneman will serve as Secretary for the 2009-2010 school year.

There were no public comments

Matt Bell reviewed the Single School Plan for 2009-2010. He indicated the following:

- There are four goals listed, beginning on page 21.
- The funding plan was provided in a memo received by all members. The Original Budget will stand for this year due to unspent funds from the previous school year. The Working budget provided at the meeting is no longer necessary.
 - Note: Goal 2.1 -- A Sign-in Sheet should be required for students attending After-School Tutoring sessions in order to monitor the effectiveness of the program
 - Goal 2.2 -- Jostens provided planners free of charge for all students and faculty this year.

Review of Program Funding: 2008-2009 carryover funding is still not calculated, but should be around \$40,000. This year's allocation should be \$47,439, for a total of \$87,439. PGUSD has not tapped into SIP funds (which are categorical). The money spent this year will be based on priorities established for the school, determining if the money was spent appropriately, and will determine money for next year. Word of Caution: Carry-over funds will be severely diminished for next year, by as much as \$30K. With the state's budget cuts, there will probably be a mid-year budget cut. Last year's cut was 15%

Matt suggested that a review of expenditures be set as an agenda item for a future calendar date.

The Calendar for 2009-2010 meetings was set. With the exception of December, meetings will be on the 4th Monday of each month as follows:

- a. October 26
- b. November 23
- c. December -- no meeting
- d. January 25
- e. February 22
- f. March 22
- g. April 26
- h. May 10

Matt provided information on school wide standardized testing as follows:

1. ACT reports that PGHS students are doing well, above CA averages
2. STAR reports are formatted in two different ways in order to monitor students from one year to the next.
3. API Score for 2009 was 831, the same as 2008. State ranks have not come out yet. PGHS places in the top 10% of the state.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:15.
